Electrical appliances of 4 types (家電4品目の扱い方)

According to the recycle law, old and no longer used electrical appliances (televisions, air conditioners, refrigerators and washing machines) should be returned to the store where you have bought them, or collected by the store where you have replaced them by buying new ones. The store will send them to their place of origin to be recycled. As a rule the garbage collector or the general environment center will not take or accept them as garbage.



How to dispose these electrical appliances

- 1. Talk to the electrical appliances store in your neighborhood. (There is a fee for the disposal.)
- 2. Also you can buy a disposal ticket at the local post office and take or electrical appliance to the place indicated. If you don't have transportation, you can hire a collector to do so. There are several authorized collectors.

Examination for Cancer of Breast and Uterus. (乳がん・子宮がん検診)

Date: June 18th (Mon)

From 10:00 to 11:00 for breasts cancer examination only

From 12:50 to 13:50 for breast and uterus examinations

Place: Health Center(Just east of Hospital IRYO-Center)

Deatail: Breasts cancer medical examination and supersonic waves Utreus cancer examination of cellular tissue.

Accepting: 70people for breasts cancer examination.(80people in the morning, 40people in the afternoon)

50 people for uterus cancer examination.

Examinee: Women who were born before March 31st 1973 and live in Kameyama city.

Cost: Breasts examination - ¥600

Uterus exsamination - ¥500 (free for women who were born before March 31st 1933)

You must show your "Registration Card" to have these examinations.

You also have to make an appointment with the Health and Welfare Center (Please give your name, address, date of birth and telephone number.

Places will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Stomach Cnacer Examination (胃がん検診を行います。)

The Health and Welfare Section (Hoken Fukushi-ka) will carry out medical X-rays for stomach cancer on June 2nd (Mon.), from 9:00 to 11:00, at the Health Center (Hoken center), just east of the Medical Treatment Center (Iryou center).

This examination is available to those born on or before March 31st 1963, up to a limit of 40 people. Spaces will be filled on a first-come,

first-serve basis. There is a nominal fee \(\frac{1}{2}\)600 (free for women who were born before March 31st 1933). those who have already undergone surgery for stomach cancer need not attend. Those wishing to apply for the examination should contact the Health and Welfare Section (TEL, 84-3316) starting May 8th (Thur.).

Hepatitis virus medical check 肝炎ウィルス検査

Kameyama City will carry out hepatitis virus medical check as one of health maintenances of citizen as follows:

Medical check period: June 1 (Sun) to December 27 (Sat) (within office hours)

Check items: hepatitis C virus and hepatitis B virus

Eligible person: Registered Kameyama resident, age over 40 who requires information

Application period : May 23 (Fri) to November 28 (Fri) Fee : Free (Free coupon or medical card is required.)

The Children Support Aid System (児童手当制度と更新手続き)

Only parents with children up to six years old can apply for the public children support aid. Application from parents with high monthly income is not accepted. Those who have one child will receive from the City Hall the amount \$5,000, the second child also \$5,000, the third child \$10,000, every month.

The public aid will be deposited in the parent's bank account three times a year, in February, June and October. The application should be submitted to the City Hall within 15 days after change of address or the birth of the child. Your bankbook and stamp "Inkan" are needed. Post office books are not accepted.

Those who are registered as residents in Kameyama City from January 1st should submit an income statement form "Jidou-teate you no Shotoku-shoumeisho".

Application for the child support aid "Jidou teate" should be renewed every year. When you receive a renewal application form, you have to visit the City Hall. The aid will be canceled if you don't. For more information consult Kameyama City Hall.
